

Local Rules

The Saxons at this moment in time have 6 pistes, each measuring 13 metres by 3 metres approximately.

- A) The Starting circle must be 1 metre from the edge on the piste.
- B) The circle must be 35 to 50 centimetres in diameter.
- C) The jack/cochonnet must be thrown to a distance of between 6 and 10 metres.
- D) The jack/cochonnet must be a minimum of 50 centimetres away from the strings separating the pistes and 1 metre from the wooden end boundary.
- E) The Boule is deemed to be out of play if it touches the wooden surrounds or if the string can be seen totally after the boule has crossed.
- F) At the start of the next end the circle must be drawn where the jack/cochonnet finished, or the circle can be moved back by up to 3 metres in line with where it finished.
