## 3. Treasurer's report

Income for the period 1<sup>st</sup> December 2023 up until 17th April 2024 is £1371.05 Since the last committee meeting income has been:

Expenditure for the same period £1370.42

This gives a surplus for the period of £0.63 resulting in a good bank balance of £2884.09 with £0.00 cash in hand. We hold a stock of clothing which at cost is about £281.00, making total assets of £3165.09

We have about £1900.00 of spare usable assets, allowing for further website costs, Leisure Centre fees (2023/24), CPL refreshment costs, Public Liability Insurance, prizes and engraving and any piste maintenance.

The extra CPL team will increase the expenditure on refreshments for home games. Generally we will need to be careful on expenditure this financial year.
